Must be at least a graduating senior in high school thru 21 years of age, although the applicant need not have graduated high school.

To be considered for induction for exemplary bowling skill:

Current book average FEMALE – 170
 And MALE – 190
 A minimum 650 series and 250 game for females, and 750 series and 275 game for males.

To be considered for induction for exemplary service to the sport of bowling:

Two years minimum service as a league officer – center level league or travel league.
 Two years minimum service to youth leaders – center and city level.

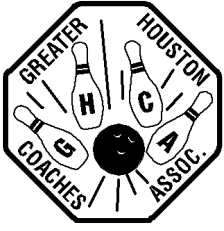
