Boys Scratch -- Girls Scratch

Boys Handicap -- Girls Handicap

Qualifier: Bowl 4 games across 2 Pairs of Lanes. Bowl 2 games then move 1 pair (lane 1-2 swap with 3-4, 5-6 swap with 7-8 and so forth) within each division.

Top 50% in each division will advance to Survivor Finals.

Survivor Finals: Bowl 1 game on a pair of lanes with others in your division, lanes are randomly assigned. Handicap will be added in the handicap division. The low person on each pair is out. Remaining bowlers will be randomly assigned lanes and bowl 1 game. Again the low person on the pair is out. This is repeated until there is one person remaining in each division.

Division: BOYS SCH BOYS HDCP GIRLS SCH GIRLS HDCP (CIRCLE ONE DIVISION)

1. All participants must be currently holding a 2008-2009 USBC Membership Card.
2. Averages: Highest average with at least 21 games as of MAY 1, 2009 from a USBC certified league (USBC Rule 319A). You must have a copy of the standing sheet to be in the Handicap Division. If there is no average verification at the time of bowling, the bowler will bowl scratch.
3. Divisions: There are four divisions:
Boys Handicap, Girls Handicap, Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch.
Boys 190 and above must bowl scratch, and girls 175 and above must bowl scratch.
4. Handicap: Based on 100% of 200.
5. Format:

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Survivor Finals: Bowl 1 game on a pair of lanes with others in your division, lanes are randomly assigned. Handicap will be added in the handicap division. The low person on each pair is out. Remaining bowlers will be randomly assigned lanes and bowl 1 game. Again the low person on the pair is out. This is repeated until there is one person remaining in each division.

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6. Entry Fee: Entry Fee is \$35.00 per bowler. \$15.00 lineage (excess lineage and expenses goes to scholarships), \$4.00 expenses, and \$16.00 scholarship fund. Make checks payable to the GHUSBC. Scholarships will be awarded 1 in 10 entries per division. All scholarship fees will be returned 100%. Deadline for entries is 30 minutes before squad time. The scholarship funds will be administered by the USBC SMART program. The Funds will be available for six years from the date of your high school graduation, or if you have already graduated from high school, from the date you won the scholarship.
7. Dress Code: Appropriate dress will be required for all bowlers. **NO BIKER or SPANDEX SHORTS, CUTOFF PANTS, TANK TOPS, HALTER-TOPS, MINI-SKIRTS, or CLOTHING ADVERTISING SEX, DRUGS, or ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED. NO REVEALING ATTIRE SHALL BE WORN.** All shirts must be able to be tucked in, but do not have to be.
8. USBC rules, regulations, and codes will govern this tournament.
9. All bowlers need to check in at the tournament desk at least 30 minutes prior to squad time.
